Mount Morgan 130 years ago boasted as being the richest gold mine in the world creating one of the biggest bustling towns outside of Brisbane in Queensland. Did you realise this mine produced 225 tonnes of gold, 50 tonnes of silver and 360,000 tonnes of copper mined for over 100 years and in its time so technically advanced and business orientated was a leader for mining in the country.

Mount Morgan is situated just 30 minutes drive, 40 kilometres south west of Rockhampton Central Queensland. Today Mount Morgan is a quaint, historic town of around 3000 population, nestled in the foot of the Dee Ranges. The old mine still dominates the landscape overlooking the town and the Dee River giving an eerie appearance from a time long ago.
